EXTENDED DAY

An Optional "pay as you go" extended day is offered each day in for 2.5 extra hours. (With a Minimum of 4 required) Optional Times: 8 am – 8:30 am, 2 pm – 3 pm, 3 pm – 4 pm

Cost is \$7 per hour per person. A \$1 Discount is offered for payment in advance for more than 7 hours per week.

You are asked to register with Fin & Feather directly & payments made to Fin & Feather for all extended day hours.

Daily activities are set up by our extended day coordinator. Fishing, archery, hiking, fitness and more!

HIGH ADVENTURE

What is HIGH ADVENTURES (HA) you ask?

This Special program is offered for multiple sessions throughout our summer program. It is designed for older student girls and boys turning 12 years old by Dec 31 of this year.

It is more challenging with additional adventures such as:

- 1. Fishing on the water in canoes and kayaks
- 2. Archery with recurve & compound bows with an archery tournament during the week
- 3. Fun slingshots with water balloons
- 4. Trail biking on the property 1 day (Bring your own bike and helmet)
- 5. Orienteering / lashing skills (building a tower and / or a catapult)
- 6. Kayaking trip up to a 2 hour journey on site.
- 7. Optional Field Trip for 2 of High Adventure weeks only for an additional fee:

Session #3 High Adventures the group is divided into 2 teams for a ½ day of Paintball at Friendly Fire Paintball in Upton, includes all the equipment needed along with unlimited air and 500 rounds of paintballs.

Session #5 of the summer we offer a field trip to Central Rock in Worcester, MA for Indoor rock climbing.

(We recommend packing plenty of water, lunch & and snack for the field trips). Bus ride is included in all field trips.
